

## Project 1-6 Page 37

In this project, you will create a Web page that will redirect the client to another Web site, using the meta tag.

1. Open Notepad and type in the main HTML tags.
2. Type in the title of the page, **Client-Side Redirection Using the Meta Tag**.
3. Add a meta tag in the heading section. Modify the meta tag to use the refresh command. The URL that the page should be redirected to is <http://www.course.com>. The number of seconds that it should take to redirect the client is 5.

4. Add a heading to the page. The heading should say **This page is being redirected to the Course Technology Web site**. Use the heading 2 tag to format the heading. Modify the heading 2 tag to center-align with the align attribute.
5. Add a hyperlink below the heading. The hyperlink should say **Click here to go directly to the Course Technology Web site**. The hyperlink should be to <http://www.course.com>.
6. Save the page in your data directory as **courselink.htm**.
7. Copy or FTP your page to your folder.
8. View the Web page in your browser.
